For U.K. Librarians, the Library and Information Research Group (LIRG) has recently announced:

- A new Research Prize for £2,500, sponsored by Ex Libris, for library systems-based research.
- A new [LIRG Researcher Directory](#) listing library research practitioners in the U.K. The Directory is keyword searchable and can be browsed by research topic. Researchers can enter their own name, under multiple topics if need

be, and are encouraged to do so if they have a work-based interest in research.
