Manuscripts should be double-spaced with endnotes or footnotes. Style should conform to the latest edition of either The Chicago Manual of Style or Kate Turabian's A Manual for Writers of Term Papers, Theses, and Dissertations. Authorship should appear only on a separate title page.
